Launch of NEW resources for Local Government

VicHealth will be launching a set of **new resources** for local government on the key ways to address food security. The new resources include 10 inspiring **micro-movies** showcasing the work of the **Food for All** projects.

An ‘upstream’ approach to address food insecurity

Michael Velders, Senior Sustainability Consultant with engineering and design firm Arup, will explore urban food production to address food insecurity. Michael’s particular interest lies in sustainable food production and integrating productive landscapes into city living.

Trevor Budge, Senior Lecturer at La Trobe University will discuss how land-use planning can influence food security. Trevor is a geographer-planner who is widely acknowledged for his work in integrating land-use planning with natural resource management plans and strategies.
